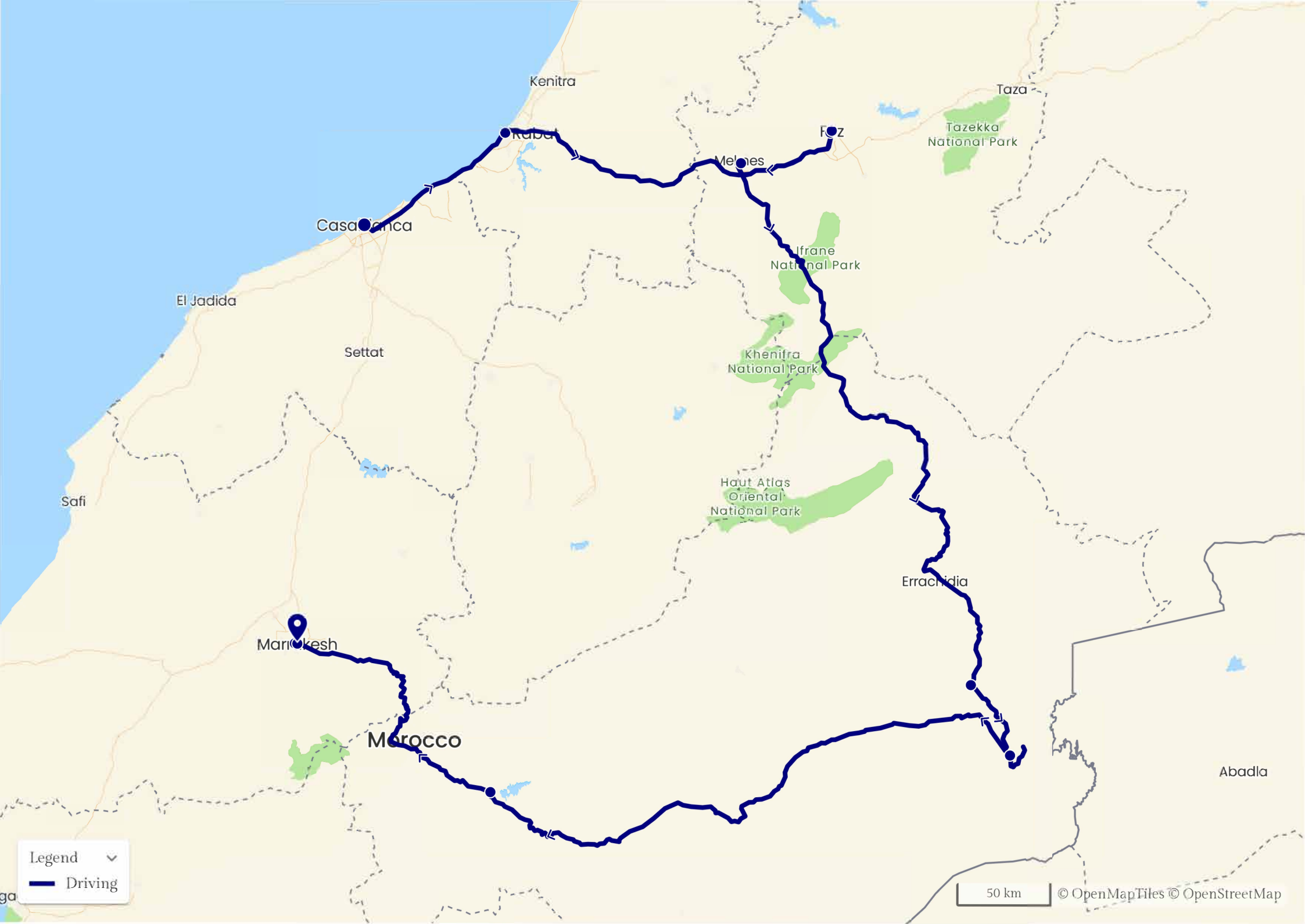

Independent arrival in Casablanca. The hotel can arrange for transfers from the airport. Please note that the transfer to hotel will take approximately 90 minutes from Casablanca airport. If arriving at the Rabat airport, the transfer to hotel is approximately 30 minutes.

Check into the Fairmont la Marina Rabat Salé. Ideally located on the banks of the Bouregreg River, Fairmont La Marina Rabat Sale is a newly built jewel. Take some time to unwind and enjoy the hotel's world-class facilities, the Spa, the rooftop terrace that offers

Day 2: RABAT - FEZ

After breakfast, depart on a tour of Rabat, the capital city of Morocco, located on the Atlantic Ocean at the mouth of River Regreg, literally meaning “fortified place”.

We begin with a visit to the Hassan Tower, an unfinished minaret that stands as a symbol of Morocco’s historical grandeur. Nearby, explore the Mohamed V Mausoleum, an exquisite resting place for the late Moroccan kings, showcasing stunning traditional craftsmanship. Continue to the Oudaya Kasbah, a picturesque fortress with narrow streets, Andalusian gardens, and breathtaking views of the Bouregreg River.

Enjoy a delightful lunch in the serene setting of Villa Mandarine, a charming boutique hotel surrounded by lush gardens and a peaceful ambiance.

After lunch, embark on a scenic drive to Fes, a northeastern Moroccan city often referred to as the country’s cultural capital. Late afternoon, arrive at Riad La Maison Bleue Luxury Hotel, nestled in the heart of Fes’s historic medina. Riad La Maison Bleue is a traditional Moroccan residence built in 1915 by Sidi Mohammed El Abbadi, a prolific judge and astrologer of his time. The Riad, now lovingly managed by his grandchildren, is typically Fassi (Fes style) and located within the heart of the Fes Madina (old city).

Enjoy lunch at Riad Nejjarine, ranked among the city's top gastronomic experiences, offering a unique setting where you can experience exquisite Moroccan cuisine. The lavish decorations and sculptured plaster will transport you centuries away to the era of 1001 nights.

Dinner at leisure. Explore Fez's vibrant culinary scene or enjoy a quiet meal in the elegant ambiance of your riad.

As the day winds down, transfer back to your hotel in Fez.

Enjoy a fascinating walk in the beating heart of Marrakech “The Medina”. Far from the touristy areas, your guide will take you to the real Moroccan life amid the neighborhoods where “Marrakchis” still live in simplicity.

Visit Dar El Bacha Museum, formally the private residence of T’hami El Glaoui who ruled over Marrakech from 1912 to 1956. We continue with a visit to the Medersa Ben Youssef, a world of architectural splendor and historical significance.

We indulge in an exquisite culinary experience at Dar Moha; a

renowned restaurant set within a beautifully restored riad in the heart of Marrakech.

After lunch, we advance to the famous Jamaa el Fna, the city’s main square.

The afternoon is yours to enjoy at your own pace. You’ll have your guide and vehicle at your disposal to explore Marrakech further, whether you wish to visit tranquil gardens, delve into more hidden corners of the Medina, or simply relax and enjoy the city’s atmosphere.

Next to Majorelle Garden is the Yves Saint Laurent Museum. The YSL Museum in Marrakech celebrates the profound influence of Moroccan culture on Yves Saint Laurent's work.

Bid farewell to Marrakech with an unforgettable evening at Le Comptoir Darna, a renowned institution blending vibrant Moroccan heritage with cosmopolitan charm. Indulge in a sumptuous dinner featuring a fusion of Moroccan and international flavors, all served in a lavishly decorated setting.
